



DISCIPLINE CASE SUMMARY

- a.** William Ernest Aspden (DOB 1938.07.27)

- b.** Incompetently carrying out duties undertaken in his capacity as an employee of a school board.
- c.** The hearing was held May 20, 1993 and December 13, 1995 in the Boardroom of the College. The report and recommendations of the hearing panel were presented to Council on February 29, 1996.
- d.** The citation alleged that William Ernest Aspden incompetently carried out duties undertaken in his capacity as an employee of a school board.
- e.** The hearing panel determined that William Ernest Aspden had received three “less than satisfactory” teaching reports between 1987 and 1990 which led to his dismissal from his employment as a teacher in School District No. 47 (Powell River). The dismissal was subsequently upheld by an Arbitration Board in a unanimous decision. In agreement with the College, Mr. Aspden undertook a program of remediation which, by failing the practicum component, he did not complete.
- f.** The panel, with his agreement, suspended his membership and certificate of qualification until he has completed a practicum satisfactory to the Council.
