



Changes to BCCT Requirements and Certificate

Please note that as of April 1, 2008 the requirements for a BC College of Teachers certificate have changed.

New Requirements for Professional Certificates

Professional Certificates will be non-expiring and require 4 years minimum of post-secondary education including a degree and at least 48 credits of educational studies (including educational coursework and practice teaching).

New Certificate Type

Conditional Certificates are issued in cases where an applicant meets most but not all requirements for the Professional Certificate. The Conditional Certificate is valid for a maximum of 58 months, allowing time for the member to complete the missing requirement

Phase-out Period for Standard Certificates

Standard certificates will still be issued until December 31, 2009.

New Look for Certificates

The look of our certificates has changed. Please see the attached sample. In order to enhance certificate security, please note that the BC College of Teachers logo has been embossed with a metallic coating and that an imprint will continue to appear over the signatures.

Duplicate Certificates will continue to be issued

Duplicate certificates may be issued to any member. The word duplicate will appear on the bottom of the new certificate. The issue date will denote when the original certificate was issued.
