



Bill 21 Teaching Profession (Teacher Registration) Amendment Act 2007 – Employers' List

The *Teaching Profession (Teacher Registration) Amendment Act, 2007 (TPAA 2007)* requires that the College establish a list of all its members who are employed by boards or authorities (employers) that can be viewed by potential employers. The Act further requires that employers provide this employment information to the College prior to October 15 of each year. This October, employers must provide employment information for the previous 12-month period, including information that identifies the members currently employed. The reporting period will be October 1, 2006 to October 1, 2007.

To expedite this process, employers will be able to upload their lists of employees to the *Employers' Area* of our website. To gain access to this area, you can apply for a login at http://www.bcct.ca/employers/Employer_Application.aspx . You will be able to access this site for uploading by September 15th.

To be uploaded, the file must be a tab-delimited text file. (A Tab Delimited text file is a text format that uses tab characters as separators between fields. The data fields do not have a set field size.)

The list must contain the following fields:

- Surname
- First Name
- Social Insurance Number
- BCCT Certificate Number (if known)

We anticipate that the employment information will be accessible to potential employers by the summer of 2008. In the meantime, however, it is a legislative requirement that the compilation of employment history begin in October, 2007.
